Our Themes

Transition to Year 1

Helping your child

- Talk about and look for shapes in the environment.
- Read stories at bedtime.
- Click on a stationary object with a computer mouse and attempt to click and drag.
- Encourage mark making and drawing.
- Encourage the use of scissors
- Encourage the use of memory- pairs games, remembering 1-7 objects after they have been covered up.
- Talk positively about Year 1, ' your teacher will be so proud of you because...!'
- Play a game. Tell me 5 things about...a bee! Change the animal or item to challenge your child.
- Run down a hill.
- Encourage counting and see if you can help you child spot numbers when out and about!
- Encourage your child's independence e.g. putting on their own coat and shoes.

Reminder

During sunny and warm days (hopefully!) we will have more time outside and in the garden. Please ensure your child has protective clothing—a sun hat, sun glasses and covered shoulders on these days.



Sun screen should be applied before coming to Nursery in the morning.

Trainers with velcro fastenings remain the most suitable footwear as sandals or slip on shoes do not provide sufficient protection and are a danger when climbing or riding on bikes.

We have two wheeled bicycles (no stabilisers) and are encouraging the children to learn to ride independently this term.
