The Halloween holiday can unsettle children so for the first week following the break home time is 12.45pm/12.50pm

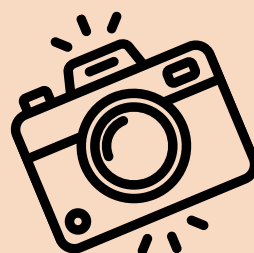


From 11/11/24 onwards home time will be at 1.25pm (N2) /1.35pm (N1) (for those staying for dinners).
